## Yoda 1.9 Upgrade + SRAM Deployment Announcement

This information is intended for Yoda end-users. Action is required regarding an account validation step after upgrade and SRAM deployment. Additional instructions and information are found below.

You may receive multiple e-mails if you have or collaborate on multiple projects on Yoda. You only need to validate your account once (or create a eduID).

### Overview

Date of Upgrade + Deployment	22 February 2024
Expected Downtime (service not available)	from 06:00h to 18:00h CET
Action Required after Upgrade	All existing uses must validate their accounts through SRAM End users will receive an e-mail requiring to accept collaboration via SRAM
Impact of Action Required	<b>Very Low to Low.</b> Existing users will validate their accounts through SRAM. This is a two-step similar to logging in to Surfconext

## Steps for Account Validation

### Scenario 1: You are Part of a SRAM Affiliated Institution

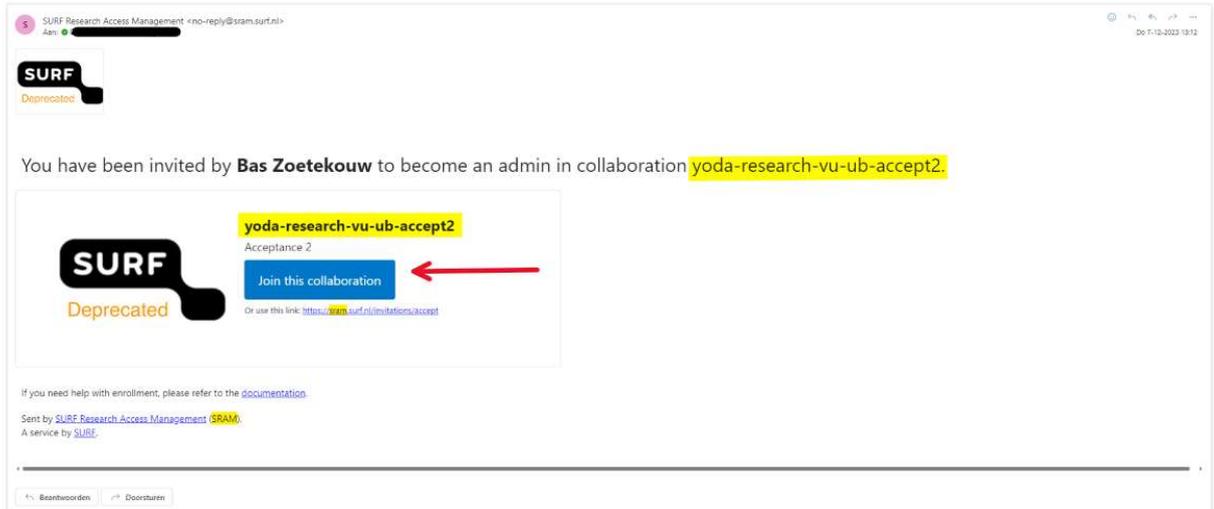


Figure 01: Invitation to collaborate. SRAM account validation. Note your project name will be explicitly mentioned on the invitation to collaborate.

1. All existing users receive an automatically generated message requiring them to accept an SRAM generated invitation. The e-mail will be sent from [no-reply@sram.surf.nl](mailto:no-reply@sram.surf.nl) (See figure 01 below)
2. Click [Join this collaboration] as indicated by the red arrow on figure 01.

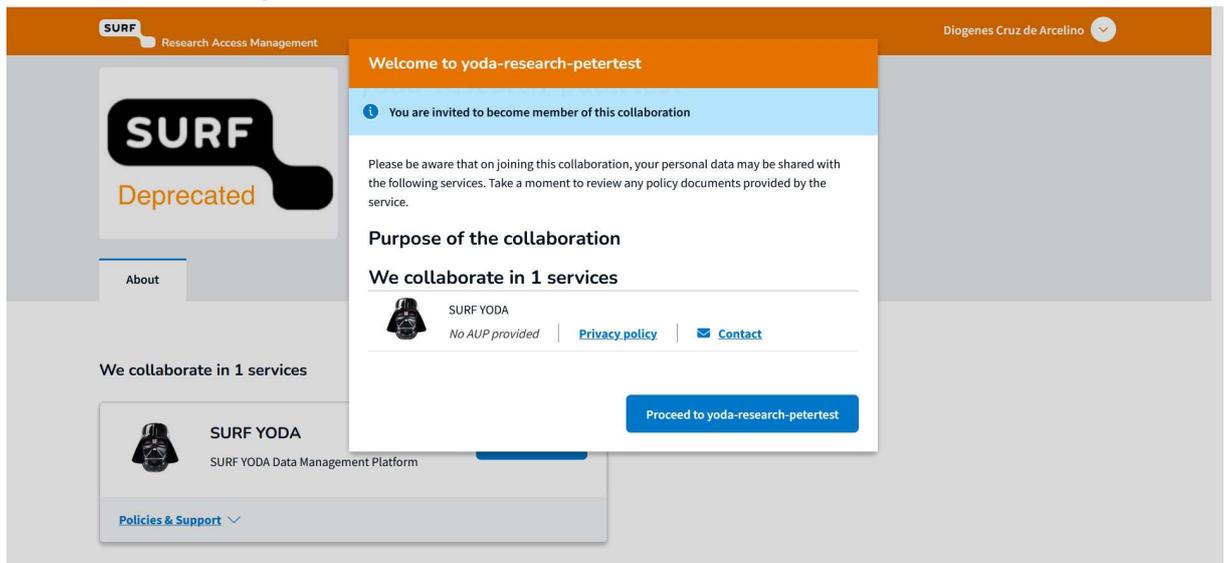


Figure 02: Click [Proceed to yoda-research-your-project-name]

3. The link on the invitation message will redirect to [sram.surf.nl/invitations](https://sram.surf.nl/invitations) on SRAM for account validation (figure 02). Click [Proceed to yoda-research-your-project-name].

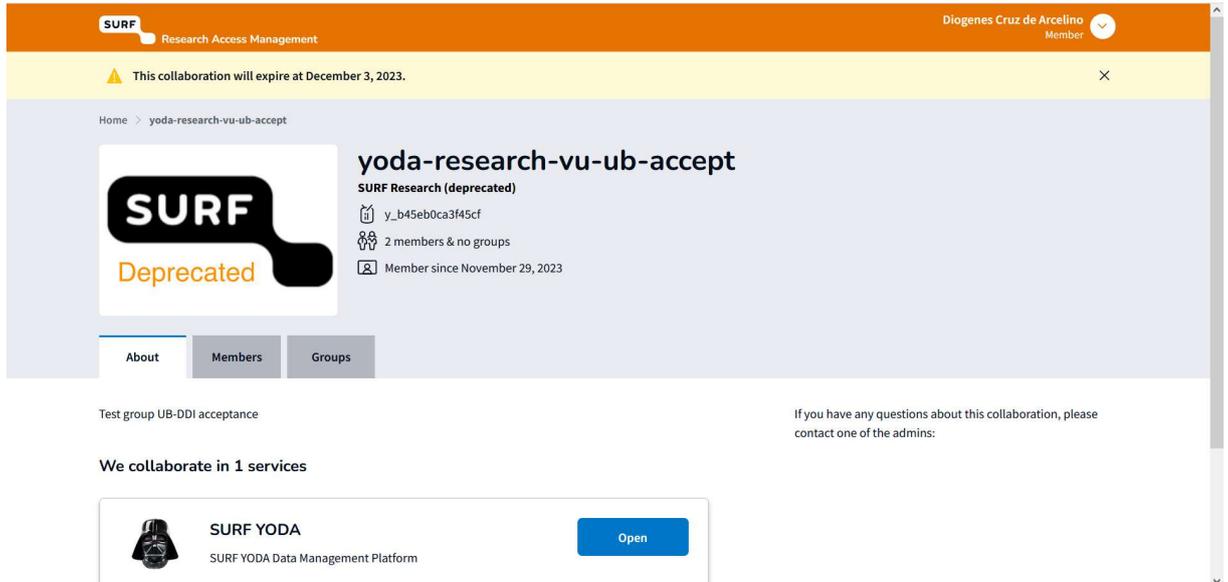


Figure 03: Click [Open].

4. Click now [Open] (figure 03)

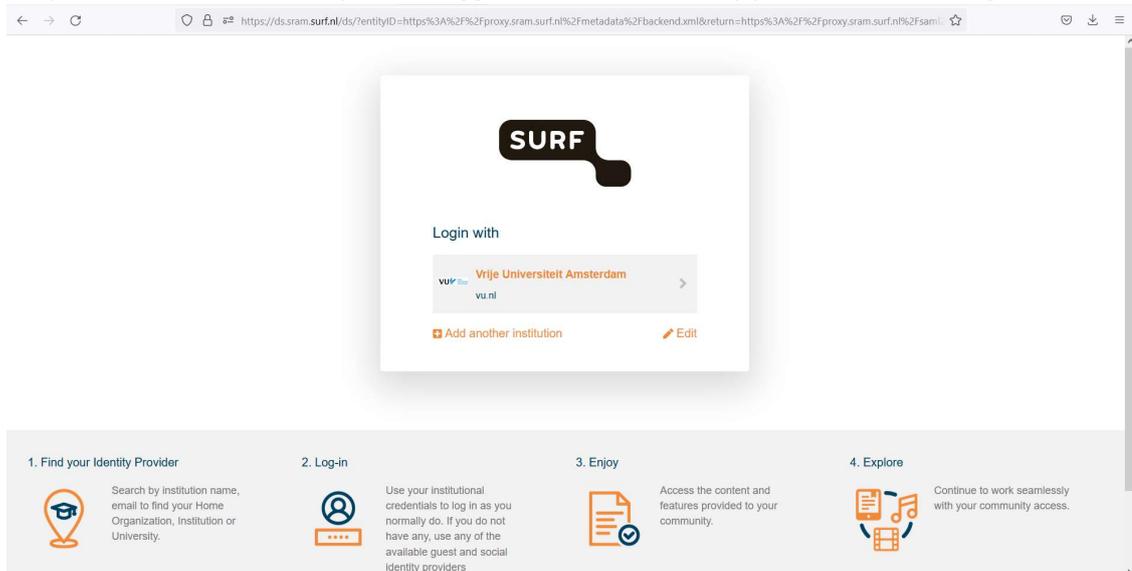


Figure 04: landing page for MFA-account log in (via SRAM).

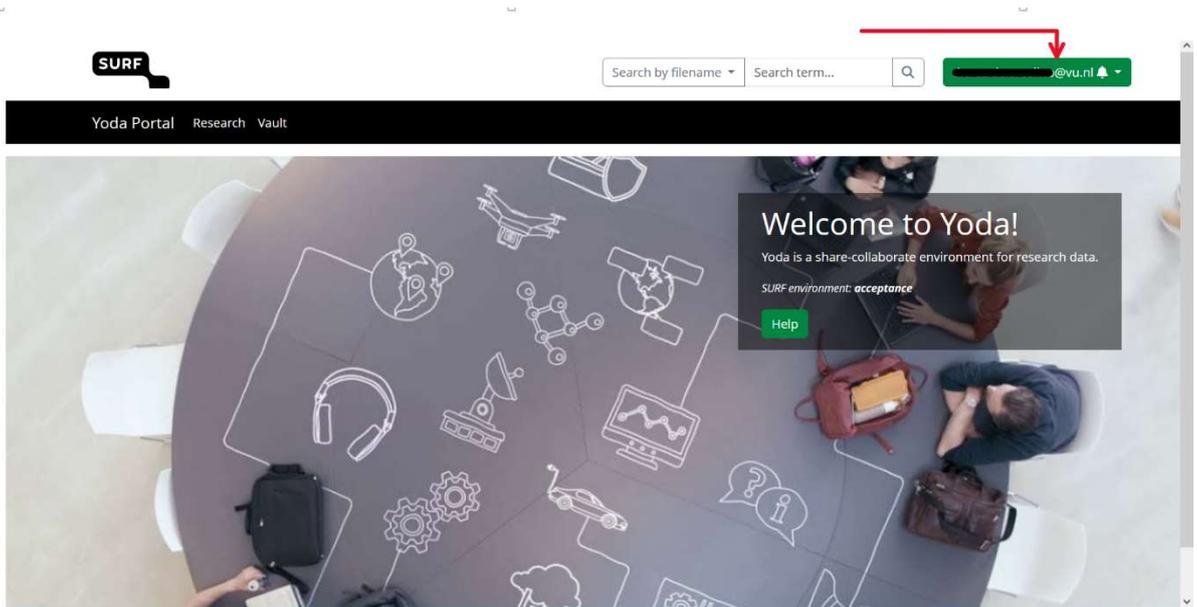


Figure 05: Logged in into Yoda (see red arrow)

5. Now you will be redirected to <https://ds.sram.surf.nl>. You choose here your identity provider/ institution and proceed to login. (figure 04). Once you have successfully logged in via your chosen institution, you are logged into Yoda and may proceed as usual (figure 05).

Scenario 2: You Are Not Part of a SRAM Affiliated Institution, and Need to Create an eduID Account

Users who do not have an institution affiliated with SRAM, will be given the opportunity to verify their identity via eduID.

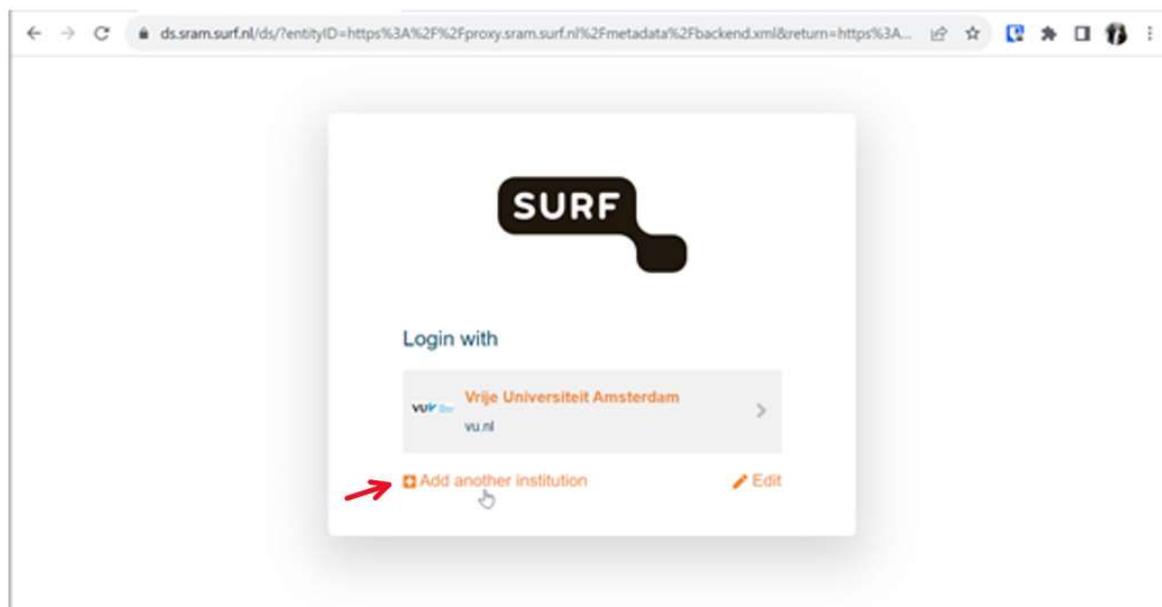


Figure 06: Choose [Add another institution] to create an eduID account.

6. On step 5. above choose [Add another institution]. Figure 06.

7. Choose [eduID (NL)] from the drop-down list

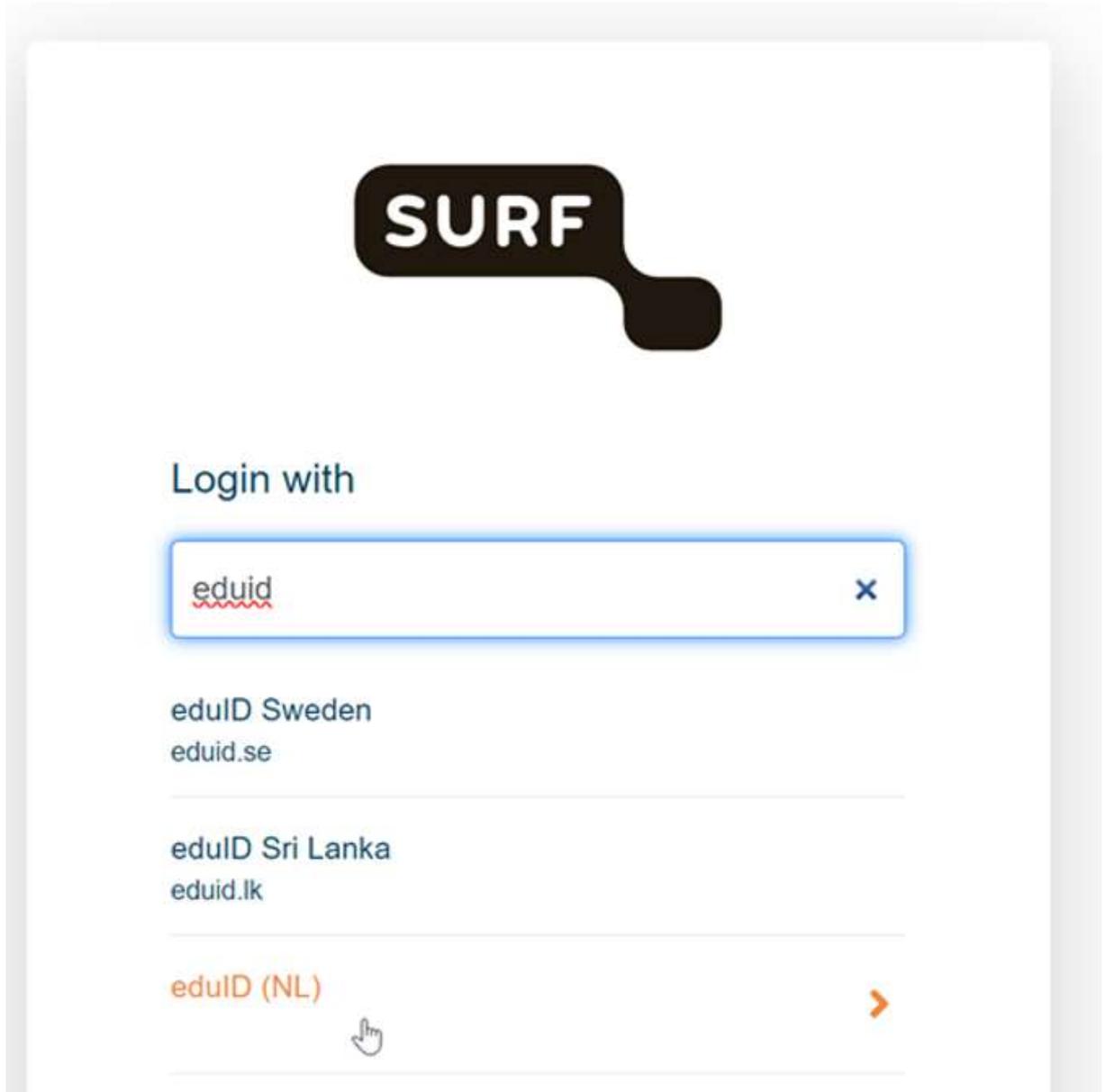


Figure 07: Drop-down list available institutions at SRAM.

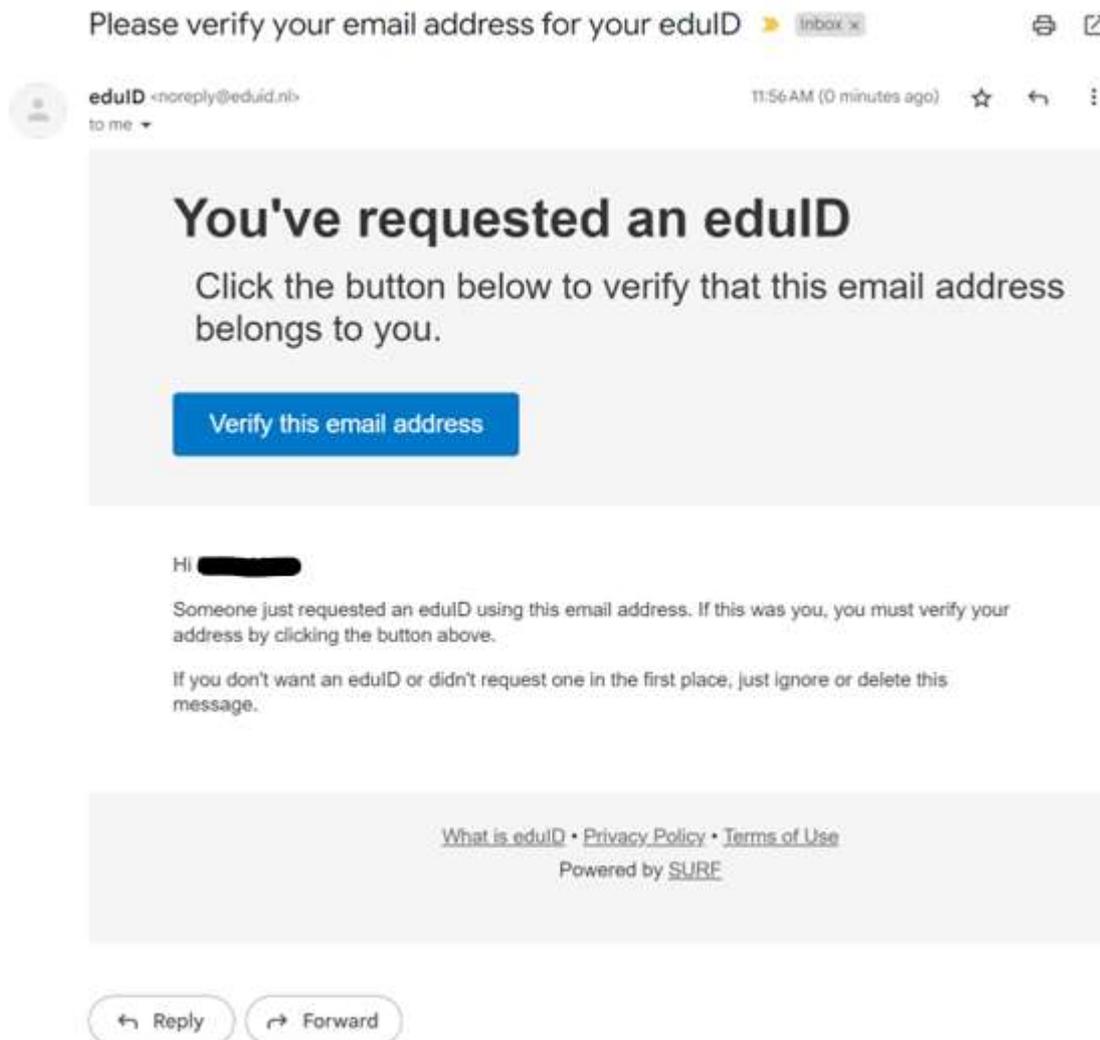


Figure 09: eduID e-mail verification for account creation.

9. Verify your e-mail and follow the instructions to create and validate your account with eduID (figure 09).
